ScienceUnlimited's major events take place in **Gauteng & Pietermaritzburg**, attracting over 160'000 schoolchildren from urban, township & remote rural areas since 2004, some travelling over 500km to spend a single day at one of the events. These are the poorest of the poor whose families are determined to let them experience a life-changing day at **ScienceUnlimited**. Since 2010, the **ScienceUnlimited Xpress roadshows** have served schools in **Stellenbosch, Tzaneen, Bloemfontein, Bethal, Bethlehem (twice), Polokwane, Vryheid, Kroonstad** and **Secunda**.
